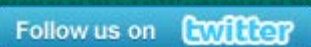
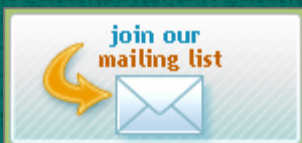

Tennis Tips from USPTA Master tennis pro Bob Anderman

Tennis is a great game. It offers competition and exercise. Plus you can play it your whole life! To enhance your game and ensure that it remains a great sport, you need to know the rules. Here are a few reminders that some times get lost in competition:



1. Player makes the call on THEIR side of the net. It is hard enough to make correct calls on your side of the net, so don't try to do it for the opponent.
2. Opponent get the benefit of the doubt. If you are not sure if the ball is in or out, just play it. Don't make a bad call against your opponent.
3. A ball touching ANY part of the line is GOOD. If you are unsure, the ball is good.
4. Either partner in doubles can make a call on your side of the court. However, keep in mind that the player looking down the line has a better angle.
